BAPTISM WITH FIRE

(GOING WITH THE FIRE OF GOD)

FASTING AND PRAYER GUIDELINES

JANUARY 07 - 27, 2019

"Is this not the fast that I have chosen: To loose the bonds of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, to let the oppressed go free, and that you break every yoke? 7 Is it not to share your bread with the hungry, and that you bring to your house the poor who are cast out; when you see the naked, that you cover him, and not hide yourself from your own flesh? 8 Then your light shall break forth like the morning, your healing shall spring forth speedily, and your righteousness shall go before you; the glory of the Lord shall be your rear guard. 9 Then you shall call, and the Lord will answer; you shall cry, and He will say, 'Here I am.' "If you take away the yoke from your midst, the pointing of the finger, and speaking wickedness, 10 If you extend your soul to the hungry and satisfy the afflicted soul, then your light shall dawn in the darkness, and your darkness shall be as the noonday. 11 The Lord will guide you continually, and satisfy your soul in drought, and strengthen your bones; you shall be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail. 12 Those from among you shall build the old waste places; you shall raise up the foundations of many generations; and you shall be called the Repairer of the Breach, The Restorer of Streets to Dwell In." (Isaiah 58:6-12)



FASTING INSTRUCTIONS

This is a corporate fast. As we draw closer and closer to the Lord, the suggested choices of foods can change. Guidelines for are below. Those who have medical conditions should consult their physician prior to starting the fast and decide together what is feasible. If you are unable to fast from food for health reasons, you may surrender other activities that hinder your spiritual growth or distract you from fulfilling your purpose and replace that time with prayer and studying God's Word.

PRAYER INSTRUCTIONS

“Evening and morning and at noon I will pray, and cry aloud, and He shall hear my voice.” (Psalm 55:17)

Pray and make declarations according to God’s Word concerning:

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JOURNALING

"I will stand my watch and set myself on the rampart, and watch to see what He will say to me, And what I will answer when I am corrected. Then the LORD answered me and said, "Write the vision and make it plain on tablets, that he may run who reads it. For the vision is yet for an appointed time; but at the end it will speak, and it will not lie. Though it tarries, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry." (Habbakuk 2:1-3)

Every day, record what the Lord shows you about yourself, your future, and those for whom you pray. Write down what He shows you in the Word, and how it applies to your life.

ACCOUNTABILITY

"Two are better than one, because they have a good reward for their labor. For if they fall, one will lift up his companion. But woe to him who is alone when he falls, for he has no one to help him up." (Ecclesiastes 4:9-10)

Identify an accountability partner. Check-in with one another periodically to support and encourage each another during this consecration.

CHURCH ATTENDANCE

"Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching." (Hebrews 10:25)

Make it a priority to attend church during these 21 days. Being around other believers will encourage you to keep going and being unified will strengthen us as a church family.

At the end of the Corporate Fast, prepare to sow a Consecration Seed Offering.

YOUTH FAST

"For You are my hope, O Lord GOD; You are my trust from my youth." (Psalm 71:5)

Children and youth are encouraged to participate in the Corporate Fast by choosing with their parents an activity or type of food to surrender. Consider giving up desserts or sodas. Perhaps at certain periods in the day, the whole family can sacrifice television, social media, video games, secular music or using cell phones/texting (except for emergencies and contacting parents).

Parents should use their discretion in adjusting the fast for their children in a manner which will be successful for them and not be perceived as a punishment. The activities or types of food sacrificed can be changed throughout the fast.

Show your children the power of fasting by leading by example. Make it a family fast where your family not only gives up something together, but also increases some things together such as family conversations and activities, time reading and discussing Bible stories, or watching Biblically-based videos.

GOD OF FIRE

The Bible indicates that God is a consuming fire. The fire of God is a fire of love and compassion, of power, deliverance and protection, of light and revelation in the world of darkness, of zeal, passion, warmth and fervency in our spiritual cold mode.

Deuteronomy 4:23 "Take heed to yourselves, lest you forget the covenant of the LORD your God which He made with you, and make for yourselves a carved image in the form of anything which the LORD your God has forbidden you.

Deuteronomy 9:3 "Do not think in your heart, after the LORD your God has cast them out before you, saying, 'Because of my righteousness the LORD has brought me in to possess this land'; but it is because of the wickedness of these nations that the LORD is driving them out from before you.

II Kings 19:11 'Look! You have heard what the kings of Assyria have done to all lands by utterly destroying them; and shall you be delivered?

WEEK ONE (January 7-13)

Day 1: Let us praise God because He has guided us to lead into 2019, after distressing turbulence. Confess your sins and praise Him for His goodness.

Lamentations 3:40-42 "Let us search out and examine our ways, And turn back to the LORD; Let us lift our hearts and hands To God in heaven. We have transgressed and rebelled; You have not pardoned."

Day 2: Exodus 3:1-10 suggest that God is the Holy Fire or is the Holy Fire. He speaks His love for the people of Israel. Enjoy the Love of God.

Lamentations 3:20-27 "This I recall to my mind, therefore I have hope. Through the LORD's mercies we are not consumed, because His compassions fail not. They are new every morning; Great is Your faithfulness. "The LORD is my portion," says my soul, therefore I hope in Him!" The LORD is good to those who wait for Him, to the soul who seeks Him. It is good that one should hope and wait quietly for the salvation of the LORD. It is good for a man to bear the yoke in his youth."

Day 3: The fire in Exodus 3:1-10 speaks of the power of God to deliver slaves and the oppressed (vs 7-10)

Exodus 3:1-10 "Now Moses was tending the flock of Jethro his father-in-law, the priest of Midian. And he led the flock to the back of the desert, and came to Horeb, the mountain of God. And the Angel of the LORD appeared to him in a flame of fire from the midst of a bush. So he looked, and behold, the bush was burning with fire, but the bush was not consumed. Then Moses said, "I will now turn aside and see this great sight, why the bush does not burn." So when the LORD saw that he turned aside to look, God called to him from the midst of the bush and said, "Moses, Moses!" And he said, "Here I am." Then He said, "Do

not draw near this place. Take your sandals off your feet, for the place where you stand is holy ground.” Moreover He said, “I am the God of your father—the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.” And Moses hid his face, for he was afraid to look upon God. And the LORD said: “I have surely seen the oppression of My people who are in Egypt, and have heard their cry because of their taskmasters, for I know their sorrows.

“So I have come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up from that land to a good and large land, to a land flowing with milk and honey, to the place of the Canaanites and the Hittites and the Amorites and the Perizzites and the Hivites and the Jebusites. “Now therefore, behold, the cry of the children of Israel has come to Me, and I have also seen the oppression with which the Egyptians oppress them. “Come now, therefore, and I will send you to Pharaoh that you may bring My people, the children of Israel, out of Egypt.”

Day 4: God speaks from the fire to show constancy of His love and relationship with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. His fire confirms His promise.

Exodus 3:6-15 “Moreover He said, “I am the God of your father—the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.” And Moses hid his face, for he was afraid to look upon God. And the LORD said: “I have surely seen the oppression of My people who are in Egypt, and have heard their cry because of their taskmasters, for I know their sorrows. “So I have come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up from that land to a good and large land, to a land flowing with milk and honey, to the place of the Canaanites and the Hittites and the Amorites and the Perizzites and the Hivites and the Jebusites. “Now therefore, behold, the cry of the children of Israel has come to Me, and I have also seen the oppression with which the Egyptians oppress them. “Come now, therefore, and I will send you to Pharaoh that you may bring My people, the children of Israel, out of Egypt.” But Moses said to God, “Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh, and that I should bring the children of Israel out of Egypt?” So He said, “I will certainly be with you. And this shall be a sign to you that I have sent you: When you have brought the people out of Egypt, you shall serve God on this mountain.” Then Moses said to God, “Indeed, when I come to the children of Israel and say to them, ‘The God of your fathers has sent me to you,’ and they say to me, ‘What is His name?’ what shall I say to them?” And God said to Moses, “I AM WHO I AM.” And He said, “Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, ‘I AM has sent me to you.’” Moreover God said to Moses, “Thus you shall say to the children of Israel: ‘The LORD God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you. This is My name forever, and this is My memorial to all generations.’

Day 5: The Fire indicates is presence of God. Pray to be in His Holy Fire Presence.

I Kings 19:11-12 Then He said, “Go out, and stand on the mountain before the LORD.” And behold, the LORD passed by, and a great and strong wind tore into the mountains and broke the rocks in pieces before the LORD, but the LORD was not in the wind; and after the wind an earthquake, but the LORD was not in the earthquake; and after the earthquake a fire, but the LORD was not in the fire; and after the fire a still small voice.

Day 6: The Holy Spirit gives us power of fire in the form of tongues to anoint and empower the disciples for great assignment to witness of Christ's power and salvation.

Acts 2:1-4 "When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and one sat upon each of them.

And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance."

Day 7: Jesus came to baptize you with the Holy Spirit and Fire Power.

Matthew 3:11 "I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire"

WEEK TWO (January 13-20)

The Holy Fire of God purifies and empowers us for us to live a life in this world of suffering, full of crisis. We shall overcome with the Holy Fire in these unavoidable struggles.

Day 8: God is a refiner's fire and launderer's soap. He will keep us clean when we falter. We need to repent and His fire will cleanse and purify us.

Malachi 3:2-7 "But who can endure the day of His coming? And who can stand when He appears? For He is like a refiner's fire and like launderers' soap. He will sit as a refiner and a purifier of silver; He will purify the sons of Levi, and purge them as gold and silver, that they may offer to the LORD an offering in righteousness.

"Then the offering of Judah and Jerusalem will be pleasant to the LORD, as in the days of old, as in former years. And I will come near you for judgment; I will be a swift witness against sorcerers, against adulterers, against perjurers, against those who exploit wage earners and widows and orphans, and against those who turn away an alien— because they do not fear Me," Says the LORD of hosts. "For I am the LORD, I do not change; therefore you are not consumed, O sons of Jacob. Yet from the days of your fathers, you have gone away from My ordinances and have not kept them. Return to Me, and I will return to you," says the LORD of hosts. "But you said, 'In what way shall we return?'

Numbers 11:1-3 "Now when the people complained, it displeased the LORD; for the LORD heard it, and His anger was aroused. So the fire of the LORD burned among them, and consumed some in the outskirts of the camp. Then the people cried out to Moses, and when Moses prayed to the LORD, the fire was quenched. So he called the name of the place Taberah, because the fire of the LORD had burned among them."

Day 9: The fire of God will test your quality, values and effectiveness. He also assess with fire on how best to answer your request through the quality of control.

Zechariah 13:9 "I will bring the one-third through the fire, will refine them as silver is refined, and test them as gold is tested. They will call on My name, and I will answer them. I will say, 'This is My people; and each one will say, 'The LORD is my God.' "

I Corinthians 3:12-15 "Now if anyone builds on this foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, each one's work will become clear; for the Day will declare it, because it will be revealed by fire; and the fire will test each one's work, of what sort it is. If anyone's work which he has built on it endures, he will receive a reward. If anyone's work is burned, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire.

Day 10: The presence is full of firepower. This gives us light, and the brightness of this light will show that the Glory of God is with us.

Ezekiel 1:26-28 "And above the firmament over their heads was the likeness of a throne, in appearance like a sapphire stone; on the likeness of the throne was a likeness with the appearance of a man high above it.

Also from the appearance of His waist and upward I saw, as it were, the color of amber with the appearance of fire all around within it; and from the appearance of His waist and downward I saw, as it were, the appearance of fire with brightness all around. Like the appearance of a rainbow in a cloud on a rainy day, so was the appearance of the brightness all around it. This was the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the LORD. So when I saw it, I fell on my face, and I heard a voice of One speaking."

Day 11: His word and His instructions are like fire, which empower us. It also separates the chaff from the wheat.

Jeremiah 20:9 "Then I said, "I will not make mention of Him, nor speak anymore in His name." But His word was in my heart like a burning fire shut up in my bones; I was weary of holding it back, and I could not."

Day 12: Fervency in the Spirit indicates fire in the Spirit. Our spirit are not dead. We must boil in the Spirit for action and performance. Boiling for Christ means we have zeal and passion. Boil for Christ. Romans 12:11 "... not lagging in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord.."

Day 13: The pillar of light indicates God's fire in the dark world. The fire gives light to dismiss darkness and its evil. It is a barrier and blockade against enemies' advancement.

Exodus 13:21 "And the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of cloud to lead the way, and by night in a pillar of fire to give them light, so as to go by day and night."

Day 14: The virgins needed oil to burn with (have) fire. You stay on fire to wait for Christ.

Matthew 25:1-4 "Then the kingdom of heaven shall be likened to ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom. "Now five of them were wise, and five were foolish. "Those who were foolish took their lamps and took no oil with them, but the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps."

WEEK THREE (January 21-27)

God's fire drives away fear and enemies. It breaks out to show God's vengeance on the enemies of God's people.

II Thessalonians 1:7-9 "... and to give you who are troubled rest with us when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with His mighty angels, in flaming fire taking vengeance on those who do not know God, and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. These shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power..."

Numbers 16:35 "And a fire came out from the LORD and consumed the two hundred and fifty men who were offering incense."

Day 15: Psalm 21 declares that God's royals have joy in the strength of the Lord. We need to trust Him and He will make the enemies as fiery oven and will devour them with fire. This will make the enemies turn back in defeat.

Isaiah 30:27-33 "Behold, the name of the LORD comes from afar burning with His anger, and His burden is heavy; His lips are full of indignation, and His tongue like a devouring fire. His breath is like an overflowing stream, which reaches up to the neck, to sift the nations with the sieve of futility; and there shall be a bridle in the jaws of the people, causing them to err. You shall have a song as in the night when a holy festival is kept, and gladness of heart as when one goes with a flute, to come into the mountain of the LORD, to the Mighty One of Israel. The LORD will cause His glorious voice to be heard, and show the descent of His arm,

with the indignation of His anger and the flame of a devouring fire, with scattering, tempest, and hailstones. For through the voice of the LORD, Assyria will be beaten down as He strikes with the rod. And in every place where the staff of punishment passes, which the LORD lays on him, it will be with tambourines and harps;

and in battles of brandishing He will fight with it. For Tophet was established of old, yes, for the king it is prepared. He has made it deep and large; its pyre is fire with much wood; the breath of the LORD, like a stream of brimstone, kindles it."

II Thessalonians 1:6-10 "... since it is a righteous thing with God to repay with tribulation those who trouble you, and to give you who are troubled rest with us when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with His mighty angels, in flaming fire taking vengeance on those who do not know God, and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. These shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power, when He comes, in that Day, to be glorified in His saints and to be admired among all those who believe,[fn] because our testimony among you was believed."

Day 16: God's anger is kindled by fire. God will not be silent over the enemies' tactics.

Deuteronomy 32:22 "For a fire is kindled in My anger, and shall burn to the lowest hell; it shall consume the earth with her increase, and set on fire the foundations of the mountains.

Deuteronomy 9:3 “Therefore understand today that the LORD your God is He who goes over before you as a consuming fire. He will destroy them and bring them down before you; so you shall drive them out and destroy them quickly, as the LORD has said to you”

Ezekiel 38:6 “Gomer and all its troops; the house of Togarmah from the far north and all its troops—many people are with you.”

Day 17: God answers by fire to His acceptance of your cry.

I Kings 1:10 “But he did not invite Nathan the prophet, Benaiah, the mighty men, or Solomon his brother.”

Day 18: Fire shows God’s approval of our offering and great dedications.

Leviticus. 9:24 “... and fire came out from before the LORD and consumed the burnt offering and the fat on the altar. When all the people saw it, they shouted and fell on their faces.”

II Chronicles 7:1 “When Solomon had finished praying, fire came down from heaven and consumed the burnt offering and the sacrifices; and the glory of the LORD filled the temple.”

Day 19: God punishes disobedience, disloyalty, complaining and fake behavior with the fire of His wrath.

Isaiah 29:6 “You will be punished by the LORD of hosts. With thunder and earthquake and great noise, with storm and tempest and the flame of devouring fire.

Numbers 16:35 “And a fire came out from the LORD and consumed the two hundred and fifty men who were offering incense.”

Revelations 20:9-10 “They went up on the breadth of the earth and surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city. And fire came down from God out of heaven and devoured them. The devil, who deceived them, was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone where the beast and the false prophet are. And they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.”

Revelations 21:8 “But the cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death.”

Day 20: The Fire of God brings change. Expect that. In our distress when we call upon the Lord, He answers by fire.

Psalm 18:6 “In my distress I called upon the LORD, and cried out to my God; He heard my voice from His temple, and my cry came before Him, even to His ears.”

Day 21: Give God glory and thank Him for being your companion for the journey. The Lord reigns with fire.

Psalm 97:1-6 "The LORD reigns; let the earth rejoice; let the multitude of isles be glad! Clouds and darkness surround Him righteousness and justice are the foundation of His throne. A fire goes before Him, and burns up His enemies round about. His lightnings light the world; the earth sees and trembles. The mountains melt like wax at the presence of the LORD, at the presence of the Lord of the whole earth. The heavens declare His righteousness, and all the peoples see His glory."
